CANE CREEK INLINE COIL

Hey guys recently fitted the new Cane Creek DB Inline Coil to my 2015 Santa Cruz Nomad Carbon, thought I would share my experience so far...

First thing to do was to set the sag, being that I like to ride aggressive Enduro style riding we set the sag at 30%.

Second thing was to give the shock a base tune before riding, here's how I set mine up.

Based on rider weight of 84kg we opted to fit a 450lb Cane Creek Volt Spring

- HSC - 0 turns
- LSC - 15 clicks
- HSR - 3 turns
- LSR - 12 clicks

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Preload - 1 turn

I have now ridden the bike 4 times and cannot get the smile of my face

Amazingly & I find it hard to answer why, but the bike just feels lighter, overall weight only went up by 80 Grams from my previous CCDBAIR CS shock.

The bike definitely pedals better, more efficiently is a better way to say it. It seems to just glide along, no pedal bob, no feedback.

Climbing, the bike sits into its sag point and just stays there, it pedals great even for a big travel bike. I do use the climb switch although you probably don't need too, I'm just like well it's there and it firms things up so just use it.

Probably the biggest stand out though is just how alive my bike feels now, it's awake! It's lively & poppy, even with 3 turns of HSR, the bike pops higher now & I've found myself over jumping a bit

I've been able to hit & clear gaps that I struggled previously.

The other stand out noticeable thing is the small bump compliance & traction, it's just amazing, makes off camber roots easy, any square edge hit now is plush, no sudden hits, it just makes everything smooth & supple. Makes you keep wanting to hit the rough stuff faster!

I am completely blown away by this shock, its performance is just very good! I cannot stop talking about it & I'm stoked to ride my big bike again everywhere.
